JOB PURPOSE

We are looking to expand and improve our financial and project analysis with financial modeling and project management skills. This position has input into the strategic direction of the business of the group in a number of markets.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The role is varied and will allow the individual to be involved in front-line project analysis and support of both a financial and a non-financial nature, including:

- Working with the Project Managers and Developers to provide financial appraisals of new and existing projects in the UK and across North America.
- Working with the Project Managers and Developers to provide general project support on new and existing projects in the UK and across North America.
- Supporting senior management, in particular the Finance Director, with project financing, project divestment and tender support initiatives.
- Assisting in contract negotiations.
- Responsibility for a detailed understanding of electricity markets, their functioning and pricing.
- Being a team player.
